PostNord introduces alternate day deliveries.

Society has become increasingly digital, and Swedes' habits and needs have changed accordingly. It's important, with half as many letters and more and more parcels to deliver, that PostNord moves with the times — so we've created a more sustainable postal delivery service that will see us deliver letters, magazines, and advertising on alternate days. We'll start rolling out this system in Region South on 1 February to everyone with a postcode starting with a "2", and then successively expand it nationwide. Use your post code to find out what your letter delivery days are at postnord.se. Daily deliveries of express deliveries and packages will continue as normal.

How alternate weekday mail deliveries will work:

Our mail carriers will do different rounds, depending on the day of the week. In week 1, they will visit area 1 on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday, and area 2 on Tuesday and Thursday. The following week, areas 1 and 2 will swap delivery days. The schedule will be postponed on public holidays, so if you would normally have received your post on the public holiday in question, you will now receive it on the following weekday.
